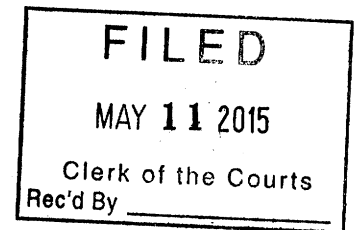

ORDER

Rule 2, Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court, provides that “The first Monday of every month shall be rule day; and the clerk shall keep a rule docket, in which the clerk shall enter all orders under these rules.” Rule 2 is obsolete because it no longer reflects the Court’s and the Appellate Court Clerk’s internal procedures. Accordingly, Rule 2 is hereby repealed in its entirety (including the title of the rule). Rule 2 shall now be designated as “[Repealed]” in the published versions of the Rules of the Supreme Court. This amendment is effective upon the filing of this order.

The Clerk shall provide a copy of this order to LexisNexis and to Thomson Reuters. In addition, this order shall be posted on the Tennessee Supreme Court’s website.
